Come to the best campground the area has to offer!

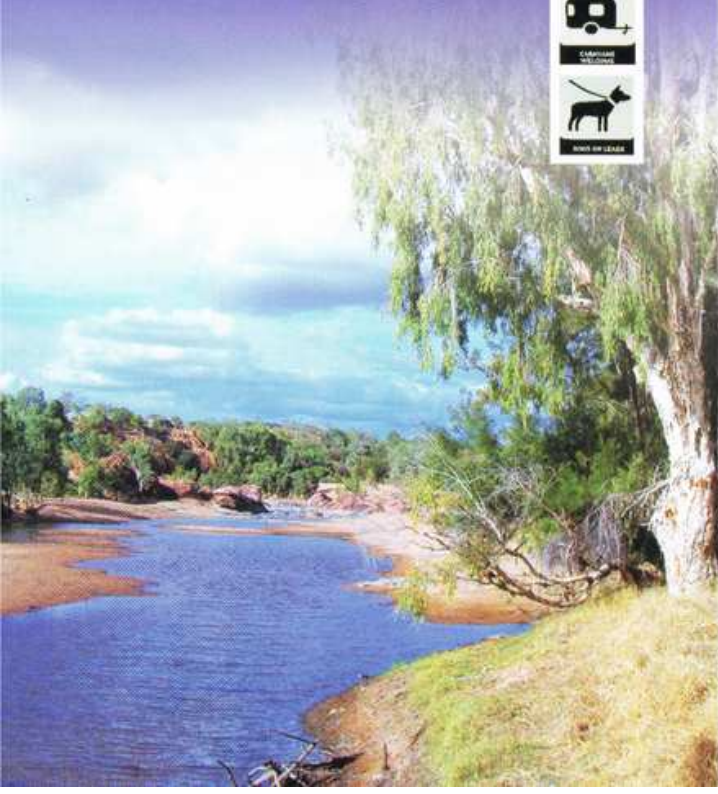
Unwind and spend some time at the quiet and secluded campground on the banks of Elizabeth Creek.

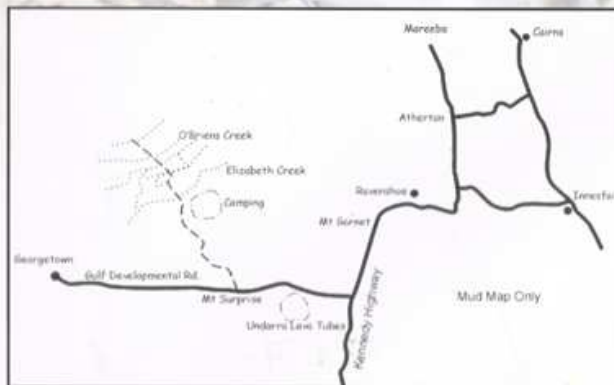
The variety of birdlife is endless.

There's plenty of things to do... and see!

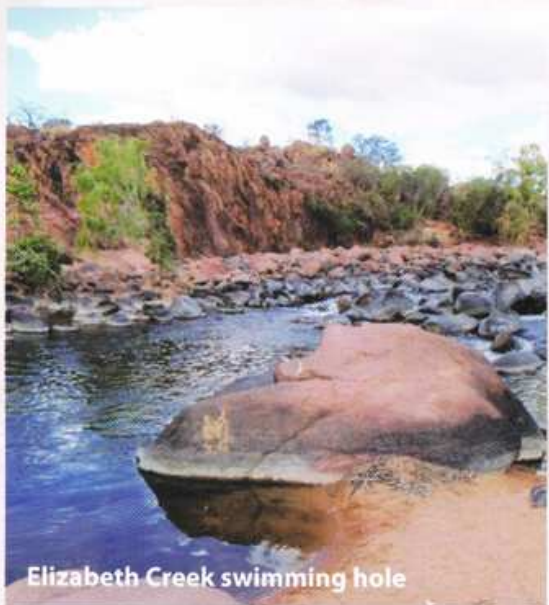
Go exploring and be amazed at the blue-green foliage of the cycads which grow in abundance in the area.

Are you interested in bird watching? Then this is the place for you. There are hundreds of different species of birds which flock to the region.

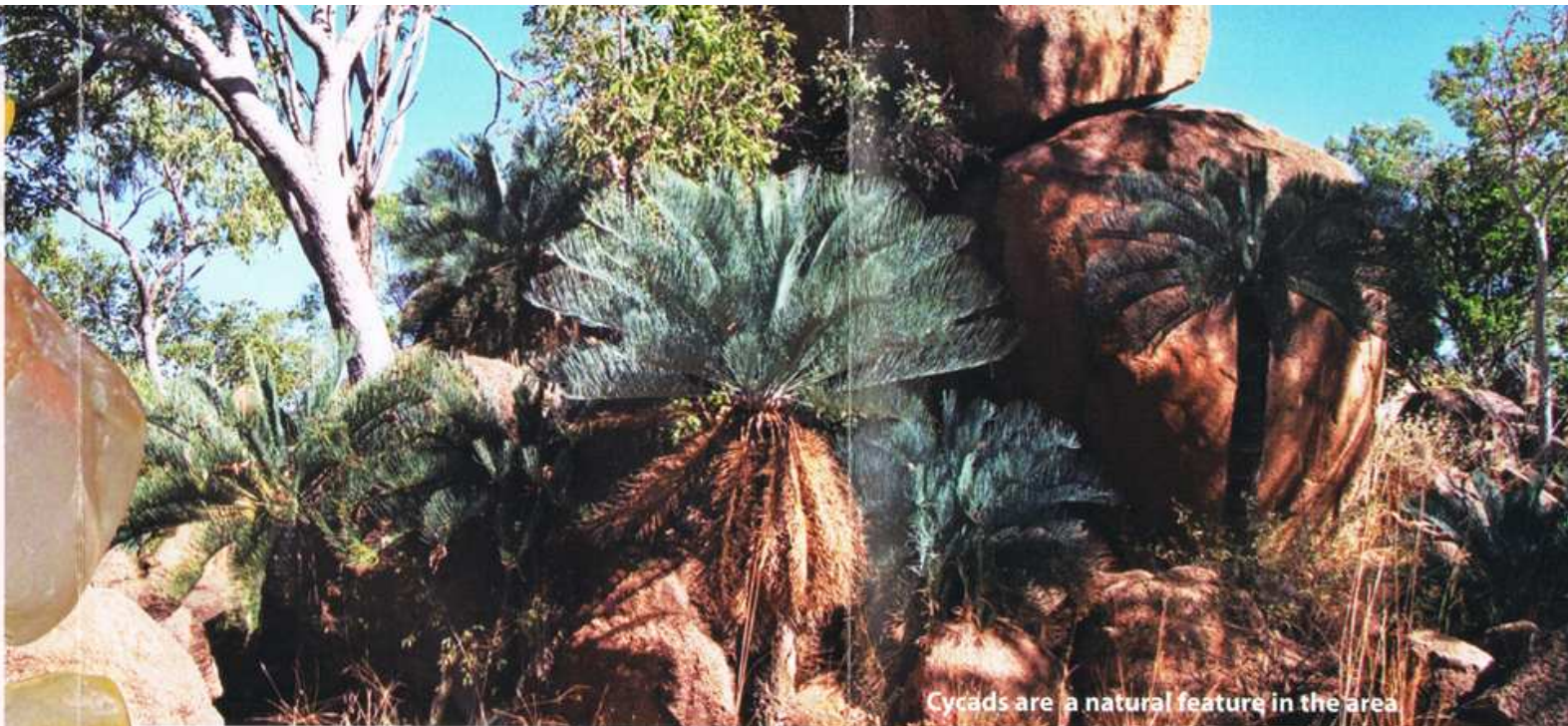
Spot the satellites in the early evening and relax by a campfire and count the stars.
